

# Columbus City Directories Search for Charles Garrison and Eusebius Weethee

I had established via the 1900 US Census that Charles Emory Garrison lived in Columbus in 1900, and that he died sometime around 1906, but that was about all I had established. I also knew that Eusebius Weethee lived in Columbus for a time, along with his wife Hannah, before their divorce. I also knew that David King Wallace lived in Columbus around 1907, when he married Hannah Weethee. Ancestry.com has about five years of the Columbus City Directory, and a brief search turned up an entry for Charles E Garrison. I decided to search further at the Columbus Public Library.

My goal was to search the RL Polk *Columbus City Directories* from about 1898 to about 1910 for any mention of Charles Emory Garrison, Eusebius R. Weethee, Hannah Weethee, or David King Wallace, or any of their children. The table below shows the results of my search.

1 I assume Eusebius and Hannah Weethee divorced around 1900, as witnessed by the separate entries that year. I can find Eusebius in the 1900 Census, and he reports as single. Hannah is not readily apparent in the 1900 Census in Franklin County.

2 I know that Charles Garrison was alive in 1906, due to the birth of his son Arthur in 1907. His disappearance from the City Directory after the 1905 - 1906 edition seems to corroborate that idea, but I cannot locate any death record for him. Minnie Garrison and David Wallace filed for a marriage license in December 1907, and were married 17 December 1907.
