This is a list of travel dates and locations during our time on the road. As of 20 September 2011, we became Oklahoma residents. We're still living in the RV at an RV park, but we're not planning on travelling as we did between February and September.

23 February 2011: Depart Columbus for Nashville

The family traveled to Nashville first because of its one-day proximity to Columbus, and Bob has family living there (Oakley and Brasel families).

24 Feb – 28 Feb: Nashville, TN (KOA Kampground)

1 Mar – 3 Apr: Muskogee, OK (Crossroads RV Park)

They chose Muskogee because of its historical background. The family had previously traveled to Cherokee, NC on a church missions trip, and became interested in the Cherokee nation. 4 – 5 Apr: Lawton, OK (Lake Elmer Thomas Recreation Area, Fort Sill)

6 – 7 Apr: Sherman, TX

Lawton and Sherman were brief stops on the way to Austin. Diana lived in the Lawton area for several years when her dad was stationed there in the Army. Bob was born in Sherman, but only lived a few years there. 8 Apr – 8 May: Austin, TX (Idyll Glen RV Park, Lago Vista)

9 – 11 Apr: Enroute Pittsburgh, PA (Austin – Muskogee – East St Louis – Columbus – Mill Run)

17 May – 22 June: Georgetown, KY (Whispering Hills RV Park)

22 June – 18 Sep: Zanesfield, OH (Marmon Valley Farm)
